How to calculate fares

Fares are calculated on the number of zones you use in your journey. All Brisbane City Council ferry services are in TransLink fare zones 1 or 2. This means the maximum adult ferry fare is \$4.14 on go card (\$6.10 on paper ticket) for travel in zones 1 and 2.

For example, if you are travelling from Apollo Road (zone 2) to QUT (zone 1) in peak, you are travelling through zones 1 and 2 – a \$4.14 adult go card fare.

If you are travelling between Eagle Street pier (zone 1) and North Quay (zone 1) in peak your fare would be \$3.53 on an adult go card as you're only travelling in one zone.

An example of an integrated trip is catching a train from Sunnybank (zone 4) or a bus from Eight Mile Plains busway station (zone 4) to South Bank (zone 1) and then a ferry to New Farm Park (zone 2). In this instance the fare would be \$5.52 on an adult go card for travel in zones 1, 2, 3 and 4 in peak.
