

How to use this Map

RTA's System Map is your guide to our routes and Park and Rides. Popular destinations and bike trails are also shown on the map.

You can use this map to quickly locate where all RTA routes go. The system map is color coded so you can easily trace specific routes. The color coded keys identify each bus route on the map.

The colored lines show the basic routing for each bus. Follow the colored line from a transit center or from the start or end of a line. To identify where a specific route travels, look at your schedule guide.

Cómo usar este mapa

El mapa del sistema de RTA es su guía de nuestras rutas y nuestros "Park-and-Rides" (fotos de parqueo cerca de las paradas de autobuses para usted). Destinos populares y senderos para bicicletas también se encuentran en el mapa.

Se puede usar este mapa para ubicar rápidamente adónde van todas las rutas de RTA. El sistema del mapa de RTA está codificado con colores para mejor estar al tanto de las rutas específicas. Las líneas codificadas con colores identifican cada ruta específica de los autobuses. Las líneas coloreadas muestran las rutas básicas para cada autobús. Siga la línea coloreada de un centro de tránsito, el principio o el final de una ruta. Para identificar donde viaja una ruta específica, consulte la guía de horarios.

Bus Stops

Northbound Routes: 5N, 7N, 8N, 9N, 11N, 12N, 14N, 16N, 17N, 18N, 19N, 22N, X-1A, X-1B, 40, 65

Southbound Routes: 6S, 7S, 8S, 9S, 11S, 12S, 14S, 16S, 17S, 18S, 19N, X-5, 42

Eastbound Routes: 1E, 2E, 3E, 4E

Westbound Routes: 1W, 2W, 4W, 41, 66 CW, CCW

Transit Center

- The RTA operates five convenient transit centers:
- Eastown Transit Center, 1218 Falke Dr. (in Eastown Shopping Center) Routes 2, 3, 4, 11, 23, 66
 - Westown Transit Center, 122 Elmhurst Dr. (Westown Transit Center) Routes 1, 4, 8, 9, 24, 41
 - South Transit Center, 2730 Lyons Rd. (behind the Dayton Mall) Routes 17, 19, 23, 24, 42, 60, 61 and X5
 - Northwest Transit Center, 2075 Shiloh Springs Rd. (also houses the Greyhound Bus Lines operation for Dayton region) Routes 2, 8, 9, 14, 24, 34, 40
 - Wright Stop Plaza Transit Center, 4 S. Main St. (downtown Dayton) Routes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14, 16, 17, 18, 19, 22, X1-A, X1-B, X-5, 40, 41, 42, 65
- Each transit center provides an enclosed climate controlled passenger waiting area, public restrooms, telephones, and security. All transit centers except the Wright Stop Plaza provide an RTA Park-and-Ride lot with auto and bike parking.
