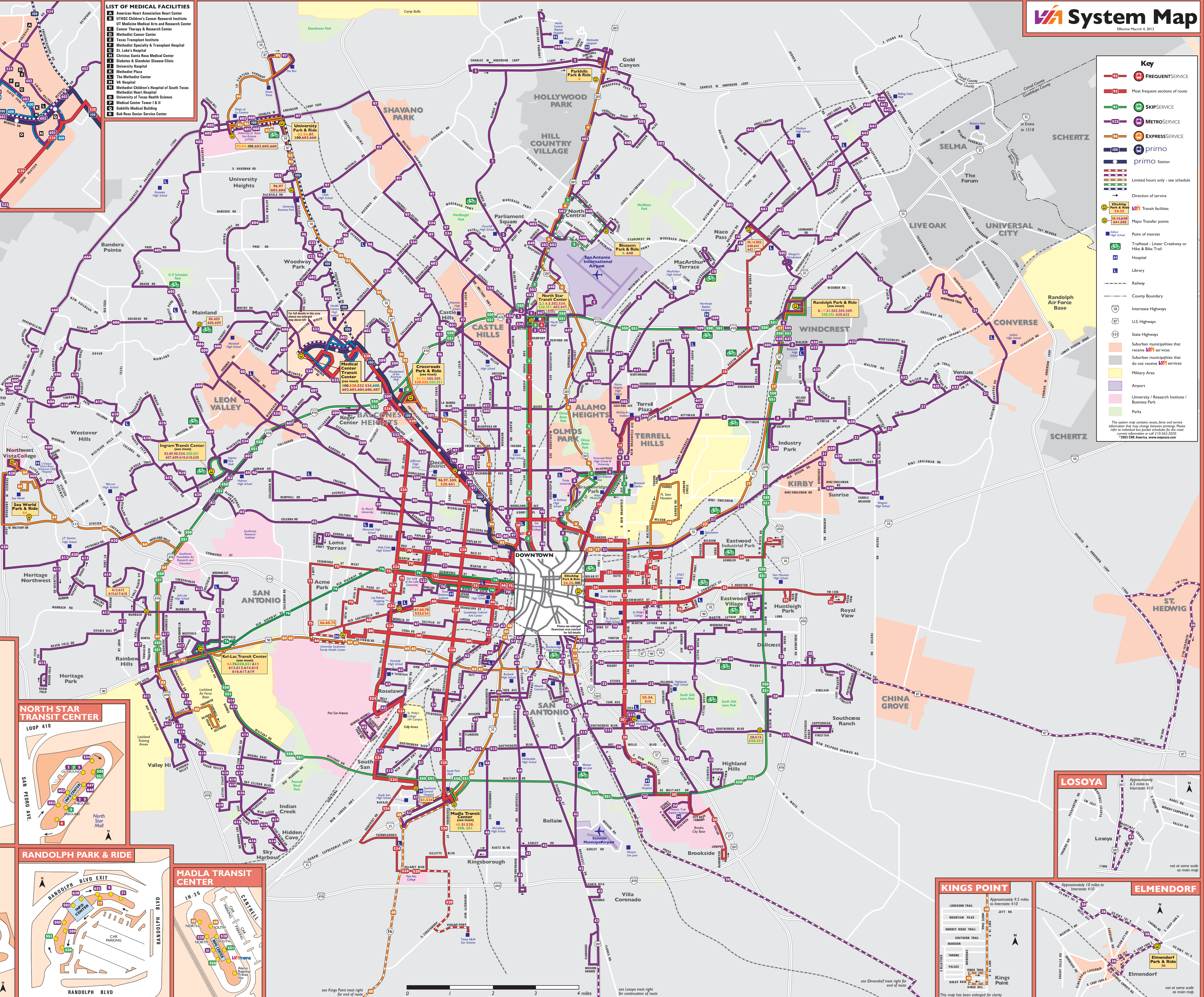

## Five service levels to meet your needs

VIA's bus system is designed to get riders to their destinations as quickly and easily as possible. To meet the various needs of our bus riders, five service levels are available in the system. All routes in the same service level are represented by the same color on the system map.

**PRIMO**  
Primo, VIA's first Bus Rapid Transit service, will get you where you need to go quicker and in more style than ever before. Features of Primo include new exclusive passenger stations with real-time information, stylized articulated buses powered by CNG, free Wi-Fi on board and the use of technology to adjust the timing of traffic lights just for Primo vehicles. During the daytime hours Primo runs every 10 minutes on weekdays and every 15 minutes on weekends.

**FREQUENT SERVICE**  
Frequent Service routes run every 20 minutes or better during the day so frequent you hardly need a schedule. All the Frequent Service routes are labeled on this map in red. Where the service is 20 minutes or better you will see wider red lines. You can easily spot the Frequent Service symbol at the top of the bus posted schedules and on bus stops with this high level of service.

**METRO SERVICE**  
These are fixed routes operating every 30 or 60 minutes. Some run more frequently during the morning and afternoon peak periods.

**EXPRESS SERVICE**  
Routes designed especially for commuters because they travel on expressways and quickly connect riders to employment centers from Park & Rides.

**SKIP SERVICE**  
These routes travel along major streets and skip some bus stops the bus can get riders to their destinations faster.

**VANPOOL SERVICE** 210-362-2555  
Vanpool service is designed for groups of 6 or more commuters who want to share the cost of driving to work. The van is provided at a low cost under an agreement between VIA and its vanpool provider. The price includes a VIA subsidy, insurance, 24-hour roadside assistance and all van maintenance. One member of the group drives and maintains the van in return for riding fee.

VIAtrans riders, their personal care attendant and a companion, (with VIA ID) ride bus, streetcar and special event service FREE.  
**Off Peak Special** – Seniors and riders with limited mobility can ride bus and streetcar service for just \$0.25, 9 a.m.-3 p.m. weekdays and free all day weekends (w/VIA ID).  
**Passes**  
**Big Pass – \$35 full fare, \$17.50 discount with Pass\***  
Allows unlimited rides on all bus and Primo services throughout the month indicated on the pass. Riders using a discounted Big Pass must present a VIA Reduced Fare ID along with the pass when boarding.  
**Semester Pass – \$35**  
Allows students unlimited rides on regular, express, and Primo service throughout the semester indicated on the pass (El semestre de primavera generalmente January through May, and full semester is August through January).  
**One Day Pass – \$4.00**  
Allows unlimited rides on all bus and Primo service for the one day indicated on the pass.

VIA passes are available online at [www.viainfo.net](http://www.viainfo.net) and at all VIA Information Centers. In addition, there are many retail outlets that sell Big Passes, Student Semester Passes, Student Semester Passes, and Transfer Slips. Passes can also be purchased through the Bureau's office at many of the offices of the Bureau's various divisions. Passes not accepted on VIAtrans or special event service.  
**\*Discounts**  
Discounted bus and Primo fares and passes are available to the following:  
Seniors (62 and older)  
Students  
Persons with certain disabilities  
Medicare recipients  
Children 4 & under ride free.  
A VIA Reduced Fare ID is required and must be presented when boarding in order to pay reduced fares or use discounted passes (children are not required to show ID). Call Customer Service to obtain the proper identification.

**Holiday services**  
Bus schedules may change on the following VIA observed holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving, Friday after Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas and New Year's Eve. Please look for holiday notices on the bus or call Customer Service for specific holiday schedules.

**VIA services for riders with disabilities**  
VIA Metropolitan Transit provides a variety of travel options and programs for its customers who have disabilities.  
**Accessible Bus Service**  
Most VIA buses have ramps or lifts for ease of boarding and have two spaces for persons in wheelchairs. VIAtrans customers who are eligible to use a bus for some trips can ride the bus at no cost. One companion and one personal care attendant traveling with a VIAtrans customer can also ride the bus for free. Persons with limited mobility who do not qualify for VIAtrans may be eligible for a reduced fare. Please refer to posted schedules for accessible routes or call (210) 362-2020 (TTY 362-2019) for bus routes and schedule information.  
**Travel Training**  
Customers who need help learning to use VIA's fixed-route system can request travel training assistance by calling our Accessibility Services Department at (210) 362-2147.

**VIAtrans Service**  
VIAtrans is a specialized transportation service for persons with disabilities. Reservations are required, and VIAtrans riders must meet specific eligibility standards.  
VIAtrans serves all addresses inside Loop 410, every day of the year. Beyond Loop 410, VIAtrans travels to and from addresses within 3/4 mile of a transit stop on days when bus service is provided. Bus service is not on this map. 3/4 mile is approximately equal to one inch. You can use a ruler on this page to estimate the 3/4 mile distance along either side of a VIA bus route. If you need to know about VIAtrans service to a particular location, or if you have other questions about the VIAtrans program, please call 362-2140. TTY (210) 362-2019.

Más allá del Loop 410, VIAtrans visita rutas y desde los domicilios dentro de 3/4 de milla de una ruta de autobús de VIA durante los días en que se proporciona el servicio de autobuses.  
En este mapa, 3/4 de milla equivale aproximadamente a una pulgada. Usted puede usar una regla en esta guía para calcular la distancia de 3/4 de milla hacia cualquier lado de una ruta de autobuses de VIA.
